INCOMPAS Welcomes FCC Business Data Services Vote

WASHINGTON D.C. (October 27th, 2016) — Today, Chairman Wheeler announced the FCC’s plans to vote on the long delayed Business Data Services or “Special Access” order during the FCC’s next Open Meeting on November 17th.

In response, CEO of INCOMPAS, Chip Pickering, released the following statement:

“Chairman Wheeler and the FCC have the opportunity to build on their pro-competition legacy by voting to curb market power abuse in the business data services market. After a decade long delay, we thank Chairman Wheeler for advancing this proceeding which will help business data service customers.”
